


Year Prep Curriculum Overview Term 4 2024

HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES

Students investigate and use familiar places using maps and models

To understand that maps are representations of familiar places and to identify features of a place.

Students will:

- Make and record observations of places
- Draw and interpret simple maps
- Create models of maps
- Use language of direction and location.

HEALTH

Students **develop** an understanding of identity and wellbeing and strengthen their communication skills.

To take increasing responsibility for their health and wellbeing.

Students will:

- **Explore** how to seek, give or deny permission respectfully when sharing possessions
- Name body parts
- Rehearse help-seeking strategies
- Express and describe emotions.
