ABOUT THE VISITING ARTISTS

Pascal Schumacher

Pascal studied classical percussion, jazz vibraphone and musicology at music conservatories in Luxembourg, Strasbourg, Brussels and The Hague. He holds a Master's degree in musicology from the Marc Bloch University in Strasbourg, and another in music with a focus on jazz vibraphone from the Koninklijk Conservatorium in The Hague.

He has won many awards, including the Belgian Django d'Or (2005), Music:LX (2012), ECHO Jazz (2012), JTI Trier Jazz (2014) and was selected for the Rising Stars program organized by the European Concert Hall Organization (2009 / 10).

Kristin Berardi

Kristin Berardi, originally from the country town of Koumala in North Queensland, is a one of Australia's first calls when it comes to Jazz Singing. Her accolades include winning the Montreux Jazz Festival's International Vocal Competition in 2006, supporting Al Jarreau and George Benson at Montreux Jazz Festival 2007, winning the National Freedman Fellowship 2007, receiving two National Australian Bell Awards for the Best Jazz Vocal Album for 2010 & 2012, winning the National Jazz Award for Voice at the Wangaratta Jazz Festival (2012), and being one of five finalists in the 2013 APRA Professional Development Awards for Jazz.

Sean Foran


Sean graduated from the Queensland Conservatorium with a Major in Jazz Piano. He also holds a graduate certificate in Arts Administration from Queensland University of Technology and a Masters of Arts in Jazz Performance with Distinction from the Leeds College of Music UK. In 2009 he was the APRA Professional Development award winner Jazz and is also a British Council Realise your Dream Finalist 2013, and multiple winner of Queensland's QSong Jazz Award in 2010, 2008 & 2006.


Rafael Karlen

Rafael is a Brisbane-based saxophonist, arranger and composer. He graduated from Griffith University, Queensland Conservatorium of Music in 2004, with a Bachelor in Contemporary Music Performance in Saxophone. Rafael received the Lord Mayor's Fellowship for Young and Emerging Artists from the Brisbane City Council in 2011 to undertake study in Europe and returned following the completion of his Masters of Music Degree at the University of York in England. He attended the Banff (Canada) International Workshop in Jazz and Creative Music in 2009, and undertook a mentorship with renowned pianist and composer Mike Nock (Sydney) in 2010. While undertaking his postgraduate study in England, Rafael studied with pianist John Taylor, saxophonist Julian Arguelles and also Karl-Martin Almqvist in Sweden.
