Responsibilities of Students Sitting Exams

- PREPARATION
 - Students must know their exam **dates, times, locations, and equipment requirements** and plan accordingly
 - Students are to provide all their own necessary materials their class teacher has indicated they will need e.g. pens, calculators, etc.
 - Students must wear full, correct school uniform at all times when at school, and during the exam block, whether doing exams or studying. Students not in uniform during exams will be required to attend a detention immediately after their exam concludes in a venue specified by the issuing senior school staff member.

- ARRIVAL
 - Students are to arrive at all sessions at least 15 minutes before exams are scheduled to begin, or as directed by their teachers
 - Students will follow the directions of the exam coordinating teacher
 - Students are to deposit bags in the senior cafeteria, N Block balcony bag racks, or as instructed for other venues

- THE EXAM ROOM
 - Students are to maintain silence in the exam room
 - Students will fill seats from the front of each row, ensuring they are sitting in the area indicated for their exam
 - Students must turn off their phones, music players, or similar devices and place them face down at the front portion of their desk
 - Students are to sit quietly, touching nothing on their desk, until given instructions by the coordinating teacher
 - When instructed, students complete their attendance form
 - Students are to follow all written and verbal instructions, and raise their hands and wait in silence for a teacher if they have any additional questions

- DEPARTURE
 - Students may not leave the exam room during the first hour, or in the last 15 minutes
 - Students are to remain quietly in their seats until instructed, or given permission to leave the exam area
 - Any student who has permission to leave an exam early must return all borrowed equipment and library books
 - Students must leave the school grounds in a timely fashion after their exam
